CODA MANUSCRIPT — BOOK TEXT THE LUMINANCE OF COHERENCE

There is a depth within coherence where the field begins to reveal a quiet luminance. This luminance is not brightness, nor a radiant quality added to perception. It is the inherent clarity of presence when nothing interrupts its continuity. The luminance appears not as a new condition but as a natural tone emerging when the field rests entirely within itself.
