CODA HEART CHAMBER — BOOK TEXT
THE FIRST REVEALING OF RADIANCE

OPENING — PRESENCE BECOMING LUMINOUS THROUGH TRANSPARENCY

Enter this Chamber as though stepping into a field where nothing has changed, yet everything appears differently. TRIAD A — RADIANCE AS TRANSPARENCY

(Corresponding to the first subtle recognition)

1. **The Question of Unobstructed Thought**
When thought arises without forming a barrier or surface, what does its transparency reveal about the nature of presence?
 2. **The Question of Emotional Clarity**
When emotional tone moves without colouring or altering the field, what does this suggest about the luminosity beneath all feeling?
 3. **The Question of Sensation Without Boundary**
When sensation appears as density within presence rather than as an experience within a body, what does this reveal about Radiance as inherent rather than produced?
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TRIAD B — RADIANCE WITHOUT SOURCE

(Corresponding to the weakening of the inner–outer distinction)

4. **The Question of Self as Contour**
When identity no longer stands as the one who perceives but appears as a shape within presence, what does this transparency disclose about the nature of “I”?

5. **The Question of World as Expression**

When forms in the world no longer seem illuminated from outside or within but arise without separation, how does this shift the sense of origin?

6. **The Question of Transparency Across Movement**

When motion in thought, body, or world does not disturb the field but reveals it, what does this say about Radiance having no direction or source?

TRIAD C — RADIANCE AS CONTINUITY

(Corresponding to the stabilisation of transparency)

7. **The Question of Stillness Without Opposite**

When stillness feels luminous without brightening and movement feels luminous without contrast, what does this continuity reveal about the nature of Radiance?

8. **The Question of Time as Modulation**

When time no longer appears as progression but as variation within presence, how does this alter the sense of Radiance as constant?

9. **The Question of the Subtle Bodies as Transparency**

When emotional, mental, and etheric movements reveal themselves as unobstructed rather than refined, what becomes clear about Radiance as inherent?

TRIAD D — RADIANCE AS BEING

(Corresponding to the full recognition of luminosity without illumination)

10. **The Question of Identity as Radiance**

When identity feels less like a self and more like being aware of itself through transparency, what does this reveal about the nature of consciousness?

11. **The Question of Experience as Radiance**

When every expression—thought, emotion, sensation, form—emerges without dividing the field, what does this disclose about Radiance as the nature of all arising?

12. **The Question of Presence Without Concealment**

When nothing stands between presence and its own nature, what becomes evident about Radiance as not something revealed, but something that *is*?

BENEDICTION — THE QUIET UNVEILING

May presence reveal its transparency in each movement of experience.

May thought arise without obscuring.

May emotion move without colouring.

May sensation unfold without dividing.

May identity appear as a gentle contour of being.
