CODA MANUSCRIPT — BOOK TEXT RADIANCE UNDER GRACE

There is a stage in the unfolding of Radiance where luminosity does not present itself as continuity alone, nor solely as the unbroken presence underlying all experience. It begins to reveal the condition in which it expresses—an atmosphere, a State of Being where nothing is strained, directed, or shaped by intention. This atmosphere is known as Grace. Not as an emotional tone, not as uplift or relief, but as the effortless openness in which the field stands when no part of experience resists itself. Radiance under Grace is not an effect. It is the natural expression of being when interference has fallen away.

Thought reveals this atmosphere first. Under Grace, thought does not press itself forward, nor does it retreat. It arises without weight. Each idea, each image, each turbulence of mind appears within presence without creating interior disturbance. The field no longer alternates between clarity and distraction. Thought becomes an articulation of Radiance, not a contrast to it. The mind displays its own transparency by revealing that Radiance is unaffected by its movements. Even when thought becomes layered or rapid, it does not alter the ease within which it arises. Under Grace, thinking is not quiet. It is unobstructed.

Emotion expresses the same quality. Emotional tone no longer expands or contracts the field. It arises as texture rather than force. Joy does not elevate, and sorrow does not enclose. Emotion stands within presence as an unpressured modulation of experience. Under Grace, emotion does not need to resolve itself. It is already part of the field's openness. The emotional body reveals Radiance by displaying that its movements cannot impose weight upon presence. Even intense emotion arises without shaping the core of experience. Grace is not emotional ease; it is ease that includes emotion.

Sensation reflects this atmosphere with clarity. The body no longer feels responsible for generating openness or for becoming relaxed. Sensation occurs without demand. Contact, breath, temperature, and movement arise as expressions of the field rather than events occurring within a separate structure. The body does not hold Radiance. It demonstrates Radiance by its transparency to its own existence. Under Grace, the body is neither heavy nor light. It is simply unresisted. Density no longer contradicts presence. It becomes part of its articulation.

Identity undergoes a subtle but profound shift within this State of Being. The sense of “I” no longer operates as the central organiser of experience. It becomes a quiet contour of presence—neither dissolved nor intensified. Under Grace, identity does not need to maintain stability. It reveals that its nature is already grounded in Radiance. The self is not diminished; it is

unburdened. Its boundaries are not erased; they cease to contract. The “I” expresses Radiance by being free of tension. Identity becomes a place where presence stands without effort.

The world reflects Radiance under Grace without altering its forms. Objects present themselves without imposing interpretation. They appear within presence with a simplicity that does not require distance to define them. The environment does not become brighter; it becomes unweighted. The shapes of the world reveal the atmosphere of being—not by shining, but by standing without resistance. Movement in the world, sound, colour, and form all appear as expressions of the same openness. Under Grace, the world does not draw attention outward. It rests within the same field as the inner life, without contrast.

Stillness and movement demonstrate Grace in equal measure. Stillness does not arise from control. It arises because nothing is being held. It is simply the natural state of presence when no effort is engaged. Movement expresses the same ease. It carries no disturbance. The body shifts without altering the luminosity of being.
