LONG INTRODUCTION — BOOK TEXT

RADIANCE UNDER GRACE

(the effortless State of Being in which Radiance expresses itself)

There is a movement within the unfolding of Radiance where luminosity no longer appears as continuity alone, nor as the unbroken transparency of presence. Instead, it begins to reveal the manner in which it expresses itself—an expression so quiet, so unforced, so free of intention that it cannot be described as action or stillness.
