

DIVINE INVITATION – CODA MANUSCRIPT

There are moments in life when something subtle begins to shift inside the inner world, long before the mind knows anything has changed. A softness appears where tension once lived. A warmth gathers behind the sternum like the early glow of a hidden sun. Awareness pauses, not from doubt, but from an ancient memory rising from depths beyond thought.
