If no government, system, or external body existed, what qualities of consciousness would remain undeniably self-evident as expressions of natural law?

7. The Question of Inner Boundaries

What internal borders persist long after outer borders dissolve, and what shifts when these inner divisions are recognised as inherited rather than intrinsic?

8. The Question of Collective Memory

Where does the memory of Humanity's long journey through domination, suppression, and distortion reside, and what awakens when that memory is met without identification?

9. The Question of Restoration

What arises in the centre of being when Freedom is understood not as a future achievement, but as a return to a pre-existing state of divine equilibrium?

10. The Question of Christ Time

When time is no longer measured by history's cycles but by the rhythm of awakened consciousness, what becomes possible within the Human story?

11. The Question of Shared Destiny

What emerges when destiny is recognised not as personal trajectory, but as the collective unfolding of a species remembering its Source?

12. The Question of the Unconditioned Human

If all systems of control, fear, and external authority vanished in an instant, what remains standing at the centre of the Human Being, and what part of that presence recognises itself as eternal?
